### Session Descriptions

*A structured feedback model will allow participants to learn, engage, question, and develop career advancement models to implement.*

- **AEL Service Integration with Community Colleges:** This session will be led by community college and AEL leaders who have successfully integrated Adult Education and Literacy into their community college systems. Areas of expertise include: integration of developmental education and career and technical education, career pathways, student services, financial aid, advising, and semester-based registration. Several models will be presented from a variety of community college systems.
- **Serving English Language Learners:** This session will be led by local AEL providers who have made notable progress in the development of effective Integrated Education and Training models for English Language Learners, including Integrated EL Civics, college ESOL/ AEL integration, bilingual high school equivalency, and Workplace Literacy models.
- **Integration with Workforce Solutions and Career Services:** This session will be led by local AEL providers and Workforce Solutions teams who have fully integrated services across core WIOA programs. Areas of integration include: cross referral models - including the use of online forms, standardized intake processes, sharing of career services, co-location agreements, job development, and co-enrollment models. Several of these models will be presented from both small and large workforce areas.
